## The Way Forward

Venue: Congress Centre, London

In a challenge to the voluntary sector, CAF is calling on charities to make their case on sustaining public confidence in charity fundraising.

Following publication of the Buse Report, CAF will bring together fundraisers, charity chief executives, think tanks, Home Office officials and regulators for a seminar entitled *Fundraising and Self Regulation: The Way Forward*.

The day opens with CAF Chief Executive Stephen Ainger taking a look at transparency and accountability in the sector, followed by Rodney Buse, former Vice Chair of NCVO and trustee of CAF, and author of *The Future of Self-regulation of Charity Fundraising*.

Later in the morning, Kim Lavelly, Acting Director of the Consumers' Association will ask whether self-regulation actually works, while Chief Executive of the Institute of Fundraising Lindsay Boswell, will be mapping the way forward ahead of an open forum.

The seminar offers delegates a unique opportunity to address some of the crucial issues surrounding self-regulation and have their say on the future of fundraising.
